1-501 OPCON 3/82 Abn Div.					
2-501: Co A, B and D continued to estimated NVA Co in THON PHUOC DIEN at YD475485. Throughout the early morning hours repeated attempts to escape the village were blocked by the units surrounding the objective. At first light a sweep of area was begun and completed at 1645 hours. Friendly losses were light. Enemy assessment included 60 NVA KIA and 13 NVA POW. Co C provided minesweep security from WUNDER BEACH to FSB HARDCORE. Conducted RIF operation to vic YD487512 with negative results. Recon platoon minesweep security from HARDCORE to QL 1 and secured HARDCORE.					
1-502: Co A provided Bde RRF until 1400 hours then RIF to NDF to vic YD558252. Co B conducted RIF in AO with negative results. Co C established blocking position at YD554306 in conjunction with a combined US/PF operation. At 1245 hours returned to EVANS. Co D continued to secure key bridges on QL 1.
