(C) Operations Summary: a. General: TF 2d Bde, 101st Abn Div continues to conduct offensive operations in support of Operation CARDITAN II to locate and destroy VC/NV. forces, bases, and logistics in the coastal plains area and provide and the state of security for Camp EVANS, IZ JANA, and WUNDER BEACH. Enemy contact was light during the reporting period with a total of 7 enemy contacts. Todays statistics: Friendly losses - 1 WS KIA, 4 US WI. (medevac). Enemy assessment - 5 VC KI. (BC), 1 Ak-47, 4 rounds RPG-2, 1 60mm mortar, 3 BBT (destroy ed), 2 detainees (IC).

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- (1) Co A. At 0940 hours conducted coordinated attack vic YD4649.
