# 1. (C) Operations Summary:

a. General: TF 2d Bde, 101st Abn Div continues to conduct offensive operations in support of Operation CARANTAN II to locate and destroy VC/NVA forces, bases, and logistics in the coastal plains area and provide security for Camp EVALS, LZ JANE and WUNDER Beach. Enemy contact was light during the reporting period with a total of A enemy contacts.

Co A received fire from vic YD463490. At 1105 hrs from bunker containing 3 to 4 enemy. Bunker was engaged with LAW's and SA fire. Continued to move to village vic YD473485. At 1523 hrs using recon by fire, unit moved through two (2) hedgerows before enemy fire was returned. On the first burst of AK-47 fire, unit incurred 2 US WIA. Company moved to occupy psn and sustained 1 KIA & 3 WIA. Called for arty and airstrikes (3) at 1840 hrs enemy broke contact. Co A returned to FSB HADCORE at 2020 hrs. Friendly losses - 1 US KIA, 5 US WIA (medevac). Enemy assessment - 4 NVA KIA (BC); credited to RF/PF - 3 VC KIA (BC), 1 AK-47, 1 CHICOM carbine.

- (2) Co B. Conducted RIF vic YD5824. At 1106 hrs received 2 rds SA fire vic YD592255, neg casualties; Enemy assessment unknown.
