1. (C) Operations Summary:

a. General: TF 2d Bde, 101st Abn Div continued to conduct offensive operations in support of Operation CARDATAN II to locate and destroy VC/NVA forces, bases and logistics in the coastal plains area. Contact was moderate with a total of 14 contacts.

Today's statistics: 10 US KIA, 19 US MIA (13 Medevac), 1 ANVN KIA, 3 ANVN WIA (Medevac), 3 PF MIA (Medevac); Enemy assessment - 32 NVA KIA (BC), 2 SAS, 1 AN-47, 1 M16.

Received SA, AT and RFG fire resulting in 1 AFC destroyed and 3 US WIA. Ingaged with SA, AW and 106 RR. Trp A withdrew to vic YD620320 and was supported by arty. At 1135 hrs a tank from 2/A/3-5 Cav vic YD620320 received an MFG-2 round resulting in 1 US MIA and I US MIA, (minor damaged to tank). From 1210 has to 1252 hrs Trp A received 3 air strikes in support, resulting in 6 NVA ABA (BC). Trp A held in position while extensive arty preparation was fired into the enemy positions. At 1945 hrs Trp B departed for Camp EVANS, closed 2128 hrs. Mesults: 1 05 AIA, 3 US IA (modevac); neg chemy assessment.
