1. (C) Operations Summary:

a. General: TF 2d Bde, 101st Abn Div continued to conduct offensive operations in support of Operation CARENTAN II to locate and destroy VC/NVA forces, bases and logistics in the coastal plains area. Contact was light as the containment of an enemy force by 1-501 Inf continued. Todays statistics: 2 US KIA, 1 US MIA, 14 US WIA (10 medevac), 3 ARVN WIA (medevac), Enemy assessment: 9 NVA KBA (BC), 4 NVA KIA (BC), 1 BBT (destroyed), 600 lbs rice. ARVN enemy assessment: 3 NVA KIA (BC), 1 RPG-7 launcher, 1 AK-44, 1 AK-47, 7 RPG-7 rounds N TAK-44, 1 AK-47, 7 RPG-7 rounds N TAK-48

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b. 1-501 Inf. Continued the containment of enemy force in hamlets of THON DUONG SON vic YD687273 and THON PHUCC YEN vic YD 690277. Blocking positions were occupied by A 1-501, B 2-501, D 2-501, A 1-502, lst ARVN Div "Black Panther" Co and 3 PF plats. 30 2000 At 2237 hours vic YD695289, A 1-502 received approx 30 rounds of Apr 1968 SA fire. Arty was fired, negative casualties, negative enemy 1 6

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assessment. At 0120 hours the "Black Panther" Co received approx 20 rounds 60mm mortar. Arty was fired. Negative casualties. Negative enemy assessment. At 0808 hours a "Black Panther" element began moving, received heavy SA fire and withdrew. Negative casualties. Throughout the day units held in blocking posisitions while arty and 14 air strikes were delivered on enemy positions. Results - 9 NVA KBA (BC). At 1050 hours D 2-501 engaged 1 NVA. Results 1 NVA KIA (BC). At 1250 hours A 1-502 began moving from YD695289 to the village vic YD694289. Received SA, AW, and RPG or mortar fire. Engaged with organic wedpons. Heavy fire continued as Co A withdrew to be supported by air strikes. Results - 1 US KIA, 9 WIA (6 medevac). Co A also reported 1 MIA, missing prior to entering village, circumstances unknown. Enemy assessment - 2 NVA KIA (BC). At 1440 hours "Black Panther" Co vic YD684280 sustained 3 WIA (medevac) from a BBT grenade. At 1608 hours B 1-501 conducted a combat assault to LZ vic YD690 292 and assumed the blocking position occupied by the "Black Panther" Co. Closed 1644 hours. At 1655 hours "Black Panther" Co found 3 NVA KIA (BC), 1 AK-44, 1 AK-47, 1 RPG-7 launcher, and 7 RPG-7 rounds. At 1718 hours "Black Panther" Co conducted a heliborne movement to HUE. Closed 1816 hours. At 1910 hours vic YD694287, A 1-502 received SA fire and RPG round. Results: 5 US WIA (4 medevac). At the close of the reporting period the cordon was being maintained around the objective area under continuous illumination. Totals -1 US KIA, 1 US MIA, 14 US WIA (10 medevac). Enemy assessment - 9 NVA KBA (BC), 3 NVA KIA (BC).

ARVN casualties - 3 WIA (medevac). Enemy assessment - 3 NVA KIA (BC), 1

AK-47, 1 AK-44, 1 RPG-7 launcher, 7 RPG-7 rounds.

- (1) Co B. Occupied night position vic YD616243. Conducted RIF operation to vic YD628260 and to YD613260. At 1608 hours from PZ YD613260 conducted a combat assault and assumed the "Black Panther" Co's blocking position after closing on the LZ vic YD690292.
- (2) Co D. 1 PF plat attached. Occupied night position vic YD656245 with ambushes vic YD644245, YD667248, YD658238, and YD666245. Conducted patrols reconnoitering for night ambush sites from YD657253. Established night position vic YD656251 with local ambushes.

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- (3) Recon Plat. 1 PF plat and 1 RF plat attached. Occupied night position vic YD606255 with ambushes vic YD606253, YD607255, and YD685285. Conducted RIF operation vic YD617270, YD640260, and YD618275. At 0800 vic YD607 269 engaged 5 VC with SA fire. Negative enemy assessment. Established night position vic YD617267 with ambushes.
 - (4) Co E (-). Provided minesweep security N and S from LZ SALLY.

Negative casualties. Negative enemy assessment. Established night position vic YD710305 with local ambush. Negative casualties. Negative enemy assessment.

Results: 1 US KIA, Enemy assessment 1 NVA KIA (BC).

At 1010 hours vic YD622324 found 600 lbs rice and destroyed, 1 BBT grenade. At 1116 hours vic YD623326 received 4 rounds of mortar or rifle grenade fire. Returned with SA fire. Arty supported. Negative casualties. Negative enemy assessment. At 1442 hours 1 plat moved to a blocking position vic YD637320 in support of Co C 1-501 Inf. At 1710 hours plat returned. Established night position vic YD623316 with local ambulhes. Negative casualties. Enemy assessment - 1 BBT (destroyed), 600 lbs rice.
- (2) Troop B. Provided security at AN LO Bridge. Conducted plat size RIF operation to YD615280 and returned. At 1442 hours 2 plats moved to a blocking position vie YD650297 to YD649291 in support of Co C 1-501 Inf. At 1710 hours returned to AN LO Bridge. Negative casualties. Negative enemy assessment.
- (3) Co C 1-501 Inf. Occupied night position vic YD653306 with ambushes vic YD651319 and YD655316. Conducted RIF operation W to YD630308, then SE along the N side of the SONG BO River to vic YD652293. At 1237 hours vic YD 631307 received SA and AW fire from an estimated squad in bunkers. Engaged with SA fire. Arty supported. Co held in place while arty was fired and plats from Troop A and Troop B moved to blocking positions. Sweep was conducted to Troop B's blocking position with negative results. Established night position vic YD652293. Negative casualties. Negative enemy assessment.

Approx 1100 hours A 1-501 will be airlifted across the river from vic YD683277 to vic YD694288.
