1. (C) Operations Summary:

General: 2d Bde, 101st Abn Div continued to conduct a. offensive operations in support of Operation NEVADA EAGLE to limit and disrupt attempts made by the enemy to extort the VN rice production throughout the coastal plains area and to sock out and destroy enemy forces and installations in the 2d Ede Contact was light with a total of 5 contacts. Today's ΛΟ. statistics: 2 US WHA (medevac). Enemy assessment - 7 VC KIA (BC), 2 VC FOW, 5 SKS, 2 AK-47, 2 ML carbines, 1 CHICOM pistol, 117 RFG-2 rds, 57 RPG-7 rds, 5 82mm mortar rds, 152 1 2b TNT blocks, 2 18 1b satchel charges. In addition the combined US GVN forces operation in VINH LOC (D) has accounted for 432 detainees.
