1. (C) Operations Summary:

a. General: 2d Bde, 101st Abn Div continued to conduct offensive operations in support of Operation NEVADA EAGLE to limit and disrupt attempts made by the enemy to extort the VN rice production throughout the coastal plains area and to seek out and destroy enemy forces and installations in the 2d Bde AO. Contact was light with a total of 7 contacts. Todays statistics: 5 US WHA (medevac). Enemy assessment: 15 VC KIA (BC), 1 NVA KIA (BC), 17 VC POW, 3 Ml carbines, 1 K-44, 14,200 lbs rice.

b. 1-501 Inf.

(1) Co A. Frovided security for COLCO Beach and ambushed vic YD870304, YD830331, and YD818308.

(2) Co B. Occupied night position vic YD821248 and July 1968 ambushed vic YD822245. Established blocking position in support 1 7

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of operation with elements of Co C and the Recon Flat. "B" blocked from YD810 255 to YD823246 oriented N. Approx 1200 hrs "B" moved 1 plat to blocking positions vic YD809260 to YD818260, Co (-) moved NE to YD825273 and 2d Flat of C Co reverted to OFCON of Co B, then conducted RIF operation thru village vic YD820 268. Vic YD812264 found 1 Ml carbine. At 1607 hrs 1 sqd moved by UH-1 from FX vic YD815256 to LZ YD823288 and found 1 VC WIA TOW and 1 Ml carbine. At 1620 hrs the Co began moving towards FSB MONGOOSE, logging at YD822213.

- (3) Co C. Provided security for FSB MONGOUSE and secured the bridges and IOL pipeline along highway 551 and ambushed vic YD807286. 1 sqd moved overland to vic YD811285 in support of Recon Flat and Co B. 2d Flat conducted combat assault at 0646 hrs from FSB MONGOOSE to LZ vic YD825273, and established blocking position from vic YD823273 to YD833270.
