SUBJECT: Commander's Situation Report 082001H July 68 - 092000H July 68

1. (C) Operations Summary:

a. General: 2d Ede, 101st Abn Div continued to conduct offensive operations in support of Operation NEVADA EAGLE to limit and disrupt attempts made by the enemy to extort the VN rice production throughout the coastal plains area and to seek out and destroy enemy forces and installations in the 2d Ede AO. Contact was light with a total of 8 contacts. Today's statistics: No friendly casualties; Enemy assessment - 2 VC KIA (EC), 11 VC POW, 6 SKS, 2 M16's, 1 RPG-2 launcher, 1 sub MG, 1 M79, 1 AK-50, 1 .45 cal pistol, 1500 rds SA, 6 RPG-2 rounds, and 9 mines/grenades.

b. 1-501 Inf.

(1) Co A. Occupied night psn vic YD836247 and ambushed vic YD839239 and YD827246. At 2228 hrs the ambush vic YD827246 adjusted arty on suspected enemy psn. The ambush then received


