SUBJECT: Commander's Situation Report 092001H July 68 - 102000H July 68

1. (C) Operations Summary:

a. General: 2d Bde, 101st Abn Div continued to conduct offensive operations in support of Operation NEVADA EAGLE to limit and disrupt attempts made by the enemy to extort the VN rice production throughout the coastal plains area and to seek out and destroy enemy forces and installations in the 2d Bde AO. Contact was light with a total of 6 contacts. Today's statistics: 7 US WHA (7 medevac); Enemy assessment - 4 NVA KIA (BC), 4 VC KIA (BC), 1 M16, 1 SKS, 1 ton rice.

b. 1-501 Inf.

(1) Co A. Occupied night psn vic YD842232 and ambushed
vic YD844228 and YD840240. At 2050 hrs ambush vic YD844228
fired arty at suspected enemy psn. At 2150 hrs the night psn 10
received SA fire from approx 3 enemy. Neg cas. M79 fire was July
returned with neg enemy assessment. Co (-) established blocking 1
psn vic YD828229 to YD825223 in support of 1-54th (ARVN) Inf

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operation vic YD7822, YD7922 and YD8022. At 0631 hrs vic YD840230 sustained 7 US WHA (7 medevac - 1 serious) from AP mine. The 3d plat at 0750 hrs from a PZ vic YD836226 conducted a combat assault to an LZ vic YD882253, closing at O812 hrs. 11 PF's were then lifted in with the 3d plat from PHU TU: 3d plat established blocking psn vic YD880253 to YD886249, while the PF's searched the village area from vic YD887246 to YD883250.
