1. (C) Operations Summary:

a. General: 2d Bde, 101st Air Cav Div continued to conduct offensive operations in support of Operation NEVADA EAGLE to limit and disrupt attempts made by the enemy to extort the VN rice production throughout the coastal plains area and to seek out and destroy enemy forces and installations in the 2d Bde AO. Contact was light with a total of 7 contacts. Todays statistics: 6 US WHA, (4 medevac), 1 RF KHA. Enemy assessment 3 NVA KIA (BC), 9 VC KIA (BC), 2 SKS, 4 AK-47, 6 VC PW, 2 NVA PW, 5 hand grenades, 500 rds 7.62 ammo.

(1) Co A, with Recon Plat OPCON. Occupied night position vic YD810252 and ambushed vic YD804251 and YD815251. At 0730 hrs conducted RIF operation NE to vic YD851270, then S to 21 vic YD825260.
