

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SUBJECT: Commander's Situation Report 242001H June 68 - 252000H June 68

1. (C) Operations Summary:

a. General: 2d Bde, 101st Abn Div continued to conduct offensive operations in support of Operation NEVADA ENGLE to limit and disrupt attempts made by the enemy to extort the VN rice production throughout the coastal plains area and to seek out and destroy enemy forces and installations in the 2d Bde AO. Contact was light with a total of 4 contacts. Today's statistics: Neg friendly casualties; enemy assessment - 2 VC KIA (BC), 20 VC FOW, 3 M16's, 5 Ml carbines, 1 Ml, 1 SKS, 1 LMG, 3400 lbs rice.

b. 1-501 Inf. 25 2000

(1) Co A, Co C and Recon plat conducted a joint opn June 1968 with forces of PHU VANG District, HUONG THUY District and 39th 1 8
Ranger Bn. During the night Co's established blocking psns

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- (2) Co B. Provided security for COL CO Beach, ambushed vic YD868305 and occupied strong points vic YD817305 and YD803331. Conducted classes on mines and booby traps.
- (3) Co D. Provided security for FSB MONGOOSE and occupied strong points at POL pumping station vic YD775250 and bridges along highway 551 and POL pipeline from vic YD787273 to YD795285. Ambushed vic YD801285.

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- (4) Co C 2-501 Inf. Co (-) occupied night positions vic YD809186 and YD838176. Ambushed vic YD828178, YD789200, YD796195, YD812188 and YD817184. The 3d plat maintained liaison with the 741st RF Co with 1 squad at bridge vic YD750210, 1 squad at bridge vic YD781209 and plat (-) at LCU Ramp vic YD772223.

At 0629 hrs the Co's of the 1-54th conducted a combat assault from PZ vic YD696197 to an LZ vic YD623210. Closed LZ at 0652 hrs, and conducted RIF opn towards Co A, linking up vic YD641190 at 1345 hrs. Co A and elements of the 1-54th (ARVN) Inf continued to vic YD641187 and established night psn and local ambushes. At 0855 hrs vic YD632202 found 1 60mm mortar base plate.
- (2) Co B. Occupied night psn vic YD614207 and ambushed vic YD604220 and YD613209. Co (-) conducted RIF opn to vic YD606213 and linked up with lst plat, lst plat then conducted RIF opn to vic YD611223 and returned. 2d plat conducted RIF opn to vic YD600219 and returned.

Occupied night psns providing security for floating raft and bulldozer vic YD695300, a bulldozer vic YD694304 and bulldozer vic YD717299. 3d plat provided escort security for 3 bulldozers from vic YD717299 to YD695300. 1st ARVN Div Mobile Tng Team presented classes to Co (-) on "VC Ambush and Counter-ambush Techniques", "Sapper and Counter-sapper Techniques", and "VC Tactic Its Strengths and Weaknesses." At 1915 hrs vic YD695300 received 7 60mm mortar rds from vic YD689294. Neg casualties. Returned SA fire vic YD700305 where 7 VC were observed and arty supported at suspected mortar psn. Neg enemy assessment.
- (2) Co B. Occupied night psn vic YD717299 providing security for stuck bulldozer and ambushed vic YD718308. 2 plats provided escort security for 2 bulldozers from vic YD725295 to YD717299. 1st plat with 1 FF squad conducted kIF opn to vic YD720295. At 1450 hrs vic YD720295 found hidden in a bunker 1 M16, 1 M1, 1 M1 carbine and 1 LMG. At 1830 hrs vic YD717299 2d plat was moved by UH-1 to vic YD698313 in preparation for establishing early morning blocking psn.
- (3) Co C. Frovided security for AN LO Bridge and occupied strong points vic YD600310, YD605311, YD611312 and YD608308. At 2145 hrs vic YD605311 engaged 15 enemy with SA and arty supported. Neg enemy assessment. Improved defensive positions and secured minesweep NW to vic YD598309. 1st ARVN Div Mobile Tng Team presented classes to Co. (-) on "VC Ambush and Counter-ambush Techniques," "Sapper and Counter-sapper Techniques," and "VC Tactics Its Strengths and Weaknesses." At 1740 hrs vic AN LO Bridge received 5 60mm mortar rounds from vic YD614298. Neg cas. Arty was fired with neg enemy assessment.
