## 1. (C) Operations Summary:

a, General: TF 2d Bde, 101st Abn Div continued to conduct offensive operations in support of Operation CARENTAN II to locate and destroy VC/NVA forces, bases and logistics in the coastal plains area. Contact was light as the 1-501 continued a cordoned operation vic THON PHUOC YEN. Todays statistics: 5 US WIA (4 medevac). Enemy assessment: 35 NVA KIA (BC), 1 VC KIA (BC), 7 NVA POW, 9 AK-47, 7 SKS, 1 RP-46 HMG, 2 Soviet carbines, 1 M2 carbine.

b. 1-501 Inf. Continued the cordon of THON PHUOC YEN vic YD687282 with A 1-501, B 1-501, A 2-501, D 2-501, and 3 PF plats. Throughout the reporting period the enemy made numerous unsuccessfal attempts to escape the cordon. Friendly units received SA and AW fire along the northern section of the cordon. Fire was re-2000 turned with organic weapons. Throughout the day arty and 8 air strikes supported. B 1-501 moved south along the west bank of 1968 May 5 the river into the village to vic YD686286. Intense SA and AW

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fire was received Co B held in place as arty supported. At the close of the period the cordon was maintained to the north by B 1-501 from vic YD686286 to YD691286 and A (-) 1-501 from YD691286 to YD693285. During the afternoon Co B 2-501 was airlifted from the cordon and reverted to OFCON 2-501 Inf. At 1723 hours 1 plat of A 1-501 was airlifted across the river from YD692286 to YD695285 to permit the filling at the gap created by B 1-501. Also 1 plat of HHC 1-501 was employed to keep the cordon intact - results: 2 US WIA (medevac), Enemy assessment - 25 NVA KIA (BC), 7 NVA FOW, 9 AK-47, 6 SKS, 1 RP-46 HMG, 1 soviet carbine, 1 M2 carbine.
