## 1. (C) Operations Summary

a. General: TF 2d Bde, 101st Abn Div continued to conduct offensive operations in support of Operation CARENTAN II to locate and destroy VC/NVA forces, bases and logistics in the coastal plains area, and deny the rice harvest to the VC/NVA. Conduct was light with a total of 3 contacts. Todays statistics:

1 US WIA (medevac), Enemy assessment; 2 NVA KIA (BC), 4 VC KIA (BC), 1 VC POW, 1 AK-47, 1 AK-50, 1 M16.
