SUBJECT: Commander's Situation Report 192001H May 68 - 20000H May 68

## 1. (C) Operations Summary:

a. General: TF 2d Bde, 101st Abn Div continued to conduct offensive operations in support of Operation NEVADA EAGLE to limit and disrupt attempts made by the enemy to extort the VN rice production throughout the coastal plains areas, and to seek out and destroy enemy forces and installations in the 2d Bde AO. Contact was light with the exception of a significant contact by 1-501 Inf, which resulted in a cordon being placed around an estimated enemy company size force. Total statistics: 29 US WIA (27 medevac); enemy assessment: 59 NVA KIA (BC) (28 killed by Army aviation, 15 killed by TAC Air and 1 killed by arty). 1 VC KIA (BC), 1 NVA POW, 1 SKS, 1 M16, 2 CHICOM carbines, 19 60mm mortar rounds (dest), 6 CHICOM grenades (dest), 2 B-40 rds (dest), 1000 rounds SA.

b. 1-501 Inf.

(1) Co A. Occupied night psn vic YD834227. Conducted

RIF west along the canal to vic YD837240. At 1558 hrs conducted a

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combat assault from PZ vic YD822247 to IZ vic YD840214. Closed LZ at 1650 hrs. At 1610 hrs elements of 1st lift received 60mm mortar fire and SA fire. Sporadic fire continued until approx 1930 hrs. Results: 2 US WIA (2 medevac); enemy assessment: 5 NVA KIA (BC). Established a blocking position vic YD844214 to YD838220.

- (2) Co B. Occupied night psn vic YD833217. At 0522 hrs received SA/ RPG fire from vic YD823218 and YD837215. Fire was returned with organic weapons and arty supported. Neg cas; neg enemy assessment. At 0640 hrs vic YD834217 received SA fire from an estimated reinforced squad in bunkers. At 0730 hrs contact was broken. Results: 3 US WIA (3 medevac). TAC Air supported from 0900 to 1030 hrs. At 0954 hrs observed estimated reinforced sqd moving S to vic YD837215. LFT supported. At 1345 hrs vic YD832218 engaged 1 NVA with neg enemy assessment. At 1358 hrs began receiving 60mm mortar fire and intense volume of SA fire from vic YD834217. Fire was returned with organic weapons. Results: 6 US WIA (6 medevac). Contact was broken at 1415 hrs as unit withdrew to be supported by TAC Air. Established a blocking psn vic YD838220, YD834223 and YD832218. Enemy assessment 8 NVA KIA (BC).
- (3) Co C. Secured COL CO Beach vic YD845319 with Co (-). 1 plat provided security for FSB MONGOOSE. Secured minesweep N and S from FSB MONGOOSE. Continued to provide security for COL CO Beach.
- (4) Co D. Occupied night psn vic YD824223. At 0525 hrs OF vic YD825225 engaged 4 enemy who set off trip flare with neg enemy assessment. Conducted opn SW to vic YD825220. At 0800 hrs vic YD825220 received SA fire. Returned fire with SA/AW. Contact broken at 0820 hrs. Continued to move to vic YD830215 receiving sporadic sniper fire. Neg cas, neg enemy assessment. Established a blocking position vic YD832218 to YD828211.
- (5) Recon Plat. Provided security at bridge vic YD838177 and conducted mandatory classes.
- (6) Co C, 2-501 Inf. OPCON effective 1640 hrs. Conducted a combat assault from PZ vic YD665258 to LZ vic YD834208. Closed 1829 hrs. At 1858 hrs vic YD838207, captured 1 NVA POW. Established a blocking position vic YD828211 to YD837206.

- (7) Remarks: Throughout the afternoon the FAC observed the enemy running about inside the village. The gunships caught many of the enemy in the open. The enemy had apparently panicked from the air strikes and from fear of being outflanked by superior forces. Results: 15 NVA KBA (BC) and 28 NVA KBAA (BC).

At 1857 hrs vic YD652238 a BBT 60mm mortar round resulted in 3 US WIA (3 medevac). Established night psns vic YD637260 with local ambushes.
- (2) Co B. Secured FSB PINKY and ambushed vic YD678256 and YD692244. Secured minesweep from FSB PINKY S to HUE. 2 sqds securing minesweep remained at HUE Bridge and provided security while Co D conducted training. Co D completed training and relieved Co B elements at Bridge, returning to FSB PINKY at 1505 hrs. 1 plat with 1 PF plat provided security for a MEDCAP vic YD713272. Returned to FSB PINKY at 1540 hrs.
- (3) Co C. Occupied night position vic YD680237 with ambushes vic YD673237, YD682230, YD691231, and YD690220. Conducted RIF opn to vic YD664258. 1st plat with 1 PF plat continued RIF opn to vic YD673267, YD644243, YD645240, YD658250 and returned to Co CP vic YD664258. At 1640 hrs reverted to OPCON of 1-501 Inf once moved to a PZ vic YD666258.
- (4) Co D. Provided security for HUE bridges. At 2219 hrs vic YD771222 received approx 100 rds SA. Neg cas. At 0920 hrs moved by vehicles to vic YD677265 and conducted plat size training in the attack of fortified villages vic YD674254, and then the village vic YD674243 following an arty prep. Returned to HUE bridges at 1423 hrs.
- (5) Recon Plat. Secured LZ SATAN and established observation posts vic YD638217 and YD643227. At first light OP's consolidated and patrolled back to LZ SATAN.
