SUBJECT: Commander's Situation Report 222001H May 68 - 232000H May 68

1. (C) Operations Summary:

a. General: 2d Bde, 101st Abn Div continued to conduct offensive operations in support of Operation NEVADA EAGLE to limit and disrupt attempts made by the enemy to extort the VN rice production throughout the coastal plains areas, and to seek out and destroy enemy forces and installations in the 2d Bde AO. Contact was light with a total of 5 contacts. Today's statistics: 5 US WIA (3 medevac); enemy assessment: 2 NVA KIA (BC), 3 VC KIA (BC), 1 SKS, 1 M16, 3 82mm mortar rds (dest), 8 60mm mortar rds (dest), 1 flare pistol (dest), 1 90mm BBT (dest), 1000 rds SA, 2000 lbs cement, 625 lbs rice.

b. 1-501 Inf.

(1) Co A. Occupied a night position vic YD835243 with
 an ambush vic YD831244 and YD839242. One sqd of 3d plat with
 1 PF plat provided security at bridge vic YD838176. At 2130
 hrs lst plat began moving to a blocking position vic YD815263.

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At 0030 hrs Co (-) began moving to join 1st plat and established a blocking position from vic YD820270 to YD818262.
