1. (C) Operations Summary:

a. General: 2d Bde, 101st Abn Div (Airmobile), continued to conduct offensive operations in support of Operation NEVADA EAGLE to limit and disrupt attempts made by the enemy to extort the VN rice production throughout the coastal plains area and to seek out and destroy enemy forces and installations in the 2d Bde AO. 'Contact was light during the reporting period. Today's statistics: No friendly casualties; Enemy assessment - 4 VC KIA (BC), 1 SKS, 1 AK-47, 2160 rds 5A ammo, 4500 lbs rice.

b. 1-501 Inf. Continued combined US/GVN opn with all elements in blocking roles maintaining blocking psns and conducting local searches. The 2-54th ARVN Rest continued to ambush and search within the cordoned area accounting for 3 VC KIA (BC) and 6 INC.
