Memo For Record

Subject: Incident of 3 Aug with PF Company

1. Recondos had moved into 2 platoon perimeters, one platoon located at BS414864 and the other several hundred meters to the east. At 1850 hours an unknown size force fired on the platoon in question with small arms, to i9nclude AW fire. Although the bulk of the fire came from the north, some fire was also received from the south and west. Recondos thought they had moved into an ambush and called for their other platoon to join them.

2. Artillery fire and gunships were requested immediately.

- 3. Oxide 69 (FDC, C Btry 2/320 Arty) indicated that clearance must be obtained prior to their firing. This clearance was obtained after some time.
- 4. 2/502 made contact with Polite Search (SF camp at Tra Bong) who indicated that the nearest friendlies, a PF Company, was located at BS405871.
- 5. After a few minutes of artillery firing a checkfire was ordered from an unknown source who indicated artillery fire hit 300 meters from friendly positions. Replot data on fire indicated rounds landing at 41278690
- 6. Bde S3 notified of this and guidance requested in the meantime gunships were orbiting overhead. At 2020 hours Bde S3 notified 2/502 area was clear to fire on.
- 7. A few minutes later Cpt. Gorski (Recondo Commander) revealed that he had been communicating with Delta Cowboy apparently the two had fired each other up.
- 8. Further information from Delta Cowboy revealed:
 - a. Recondos had fire fight with PF Company. Delta Cowboy was the US advisor to that company.
 - AO issued to advisor was BS390860 BS390885 BS420885 BS420860.
 This AO overlaps 2/502 AO.
 - c. No casualties suffered on either side.
- 9. Earlier in the day, 2/502 S2 and S5 had coordinated directly with the district chief who stated the PF troops would not fire south of the roads and their elements would not be further south than 500 meters from the road during daylight hours until 1800 hours. After 1800 hours, all PF elements would return to their fort.
- 10. Although the Civil Affairs Annex to the Hood River OPORD indicates the Recondos are in a no fire area, direct liaison indicated no friendlies would be in the area. Further the original OPORD did not indicate a no fire area where the Recondos were on. The 2/502 Arty LnO was unaware such an area existed other than the area in the original order. However clearance was obtained by Oxide 69.
- 11. Recommendations:
 - a. Closer liaison be established to ensure AOs do not overlap between friendly elements
 - b. No fire zones be published in the operations overlay or the fire plan overlay and not the Civil Affairs Annex.
 - c. Arty LnO be notified of any changes in basic fire plan.
