Bn plans air strikes at the following locations and times tomorrow: BS593534-0800H, BS583494 -1300H, BS579478- 1730H. At end of reporting period units (2/502(-)) continue to Recono Checkerboard in their asn. AO's. Co C is securing Fire Base CHAMPS and con- ducting patrols in the general area.
