MEMO TO: The S-2 and S-5 1st Bde 101st Abn Div

SUBJECT: Control of non-combatants in the Battalion Area of Operations

1. The 2d Bn (Abn) 502d Inf requests that a Psy War team be employed in the valley bounded by BS 5847, BS 6247, BS 5855, and BS 6255 to accomplish the following missions:

- a. To impose a curfew from 1800 hours to 0600 hours daily.
 - b. To inform the people in the valley to stay in the valley, are not to use the North, South, or West trails leading out.
 - c. To inform the people in the valley not to run and to raise their hands when approached by free World forces signifying their peaceful intentions and the fact that they are not armed.
 - d. To inform the people in the valley that their homes will not be destroyed, their family life will not be disrupted, and artillery and air strikes will cease as long as they cooperate with the free world forces.
2. It is felt that by doing this we will be able to more effectively locate and apprehend the VC, and be able to stabilize the situation in the valley until the detailed search of that area begins.
