THE ARMY COMMENDATION MEDAL WITH "V" DEVICE

1. TC 320. The following AWARDS are announced.

FARROW, DAN L. BALKSL2915 (SSAN:) SPECIALIST FOUR (E) Company A
2d Battalion 501st Infantry APO San Francisco 96383

Awarded: The Army Commendation Medal with "V" Device

Date action: 22 February 1968

Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: For heroism in the Republic of Vietnam on 22 February 1968. Specialist Four Farrow distinguished himself while serving as a grenadier with Company A 2d Battalion 501st Infantry, in the vicinity of Hue, Republic of Vietnam. His company was ordered to attack a village and subsequently engaged an estimated reinforced company of North Vietnamese Army Regulars well concealed and protected by trench lines and bunkers. When the order was given to assault, he unhesitatingly moved out front on the assault line, and placed such effective fire on the bunkers and trench lines, that the enemy was forced to withdraw leaving his dead and wounded behind. Specialist Farrow's heroic actions were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
