Awarded: The Army Commendation Medal with "V" Device

Date of service? 29 August 1970 Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Authority: By direction of the Escretary of the Army under the previsions of AR 672-5-1

Reason: For heroism in the Republic of Vietnam on 29 August 1970. Private Clark distinguished himself while serving as a rifleman in Company D, 2d Battalion (Airmobile), 502d Infantry, during combat operations in Thua Thien Province, Republic of Vietnam. While conducting a combat sweep, Private Clark came under intense fire from an enemy bunker complex. Maneuvering forward to a more advantageous position, he delivered accurate suppressive fire on the enemy. Subjecting himself to the hostile fire, he placed covering fire which enabled his compades to evacuate the wounded. His actions were instrumental in gaining fire superiority and silencing the enemy position. Frivate Clark's personal bravery and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
