Date action: 2 October 1967 Theater: Republic of Viet Nam

Reason: For heroism in connection with military operations against a hostile force: Private Johnson distinguished himself by exceptionally valorous action on 2 October 1967 in the Republic of Viet Nam. During an attack on well fortified enemy positions, Private Johnson's squad became pinned down by a heavy volume of enemy automatic weapons fire. Realizing the precarious position his equad was in, Private Johnson with complete disregard for his own safety, charged forward throwing grenades and firing his weapon into the enemy position and succeeded in destroying it, killing two enemy soldiers. As his squad continued to move forward in the assault, Private Johnson was struck by enemy fire and killed instantly. Private Johnson's devotion to duty and personal courage were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service, and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
