Awarded: Bronze Star Medal with "V" Device

Date action: 9 July 1967 Theater: Republic of Viet Nam

Reason: For heroism in connection with military operations against a hostile force: Specialist Yaklich distinguished himself by exceptionally valorous actions on 9 July 1967 in the Republic of Viet Nam. Specialist Yaklich was moving down a jungle trail with his platoon when heavy enemy fire broke out to their front. He observed several enemy soldiers placing murderous fire upon the lead squad of his platoon from a well concealed tunnel complex. Specialist Yaklich, with complete disregard for his own safety, charged through the withering hail of enemy fire, delivering intense and effective fire from his weapon against the enemy, and assaulted the enemy position. Having silenced the position with his aggressive assault, he entered the turnel complex and extracted one dead enemy soldier, ten prisoners and one captured enemy weapon. Spec ialist Yaklich's devotion to duty and personal courage were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service, and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
