- force: Lieutenant Orvold distinguished himself by exceptionally valorous actions on 19 August 1967 in the Republic of Viet Nam. Lieutenant Orvold's platoon was called to support a sister platoon that had been ambushed by the enemy. Upon arriving at the battle area, Lieutenant Orvold, although under intense enemy fire, personally positioned his men to repel the enemy attack. With complete disregard for his own safety, he excosed himself to enemy fire while moving among his positions directing the fire of his men. As a result of his heroic actions and superlative judgment, his platoon completely routed the enemy positions. His platoon accounted for three enemy soldiers killed and several others wounded. Lieutenaut Orvold's devotion to duty and personal courage were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service, and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
