## AWARD OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL FOR HEROISM (FOSTHIMOUS)

1. TC 320. The following AWARD is announced.

INGLES, DANNY L.

SPECIALIST FOUR E4 USA

Co B, 2d Bn, 502d Inf, 1st Bde, 101st Abn Div, APO 96347

Awarded: Bronze Star Medal with "V" Device (Posthumously)

Date action: 13 August 1967

Theater: Republic of Viet Nam

Reason: For heroism in connection with military operations against a hostile force: Specialist Ingles distinguished himself by exceptionally valorous actions on 13 August 1967 in the Republic of Viet Nam. Specialist Ingles was walking point for his platoon when they were suddenly brought under attack by an estimated reinforced North Vietnamese army battalion. Seeing one of his comrades wounded in the initial burst of fire, he immediately left his covered position and, with complete disregard for his own safety, charged through the energy's intense hail of fire to aid his badly wounded comrade. After administering medical aid to him, Specialist Ingles picked him up and started toward a landing zone with him. The enemy immediately concentrated their fire on Specialist Ingles. As he was approaching the landing zone, the intense enemy fire increased to such a degree that Specialist Ingles was pinned down and mortally wounded while shielding his wounded comrade from the incoming mortar and small arms fire, Specialist Ingles devotion to duty and personal courage were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service, and reflect great credit upon him-

self, his unit, and the United States Army. Authority: By direction of the President under the provisions of Executive
