AWARD OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL FOR HEROISM

1. TC 320. The following AWARD is announced.

REYNOLDS, HARVEY C. STAFF SERGEANT E6 USA Co G, 2nd Bn, 502nd Inf
Awarded: Bronze Star Medal with "V" Device First Oak Leaf Cluster
Date action: 29 September 1967
Theater: Republic of Viet Nam
Reason: For heroism in connection with military operations against a hostile force: Sergeant Reynolds distinguished himself by exceptionally valorous actions on 29 September 1967 in the Republic of Viet Nam. While moving to reinforce a sister platoon that was under heavy enemy fire and pinned down, Sergeant Reynold's platoon was suddenly taken under an intense volume of enemy automatic weapons fire, realizing the immediate need for reaching the beleaguered platoon, Sergeant Reynolds immediately began to maneuver his platoon against the enemy in an effort to reach the sister platoon. Successfully overcomng the enemy and joining with the pinned down platoon, Sergeant Reynolds was wounded by a burst from an enemy automatic weapon. Disregarding his wound, he continued to supervise his men and with complete disregard for his own safety, he continually exposed himself to the vicious enemy fire while moving from position to position directing the fire of his men. Through Sergeant Reynolds untiring efforts the enemy force was driven off and the beleaguered platoon relieved. Sergeant Reynold's devotion to duty and personal courage were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service, and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
