Company & was preoping on area adjacent to the village when it amountered a heavily mined area. As a result of the consequent mine detenations, the company sustained twenty-four wounded and one killed. First Lieutenant Adms ismediately organized a litter detail and fearlashly led it into the uncleared mine field to extract the wounded troopers. With utter disregard for his personal salety. First Leutenant Adams dauntlessig entered the dangerous area on numerous subsequent occasions to minister to the needs of the wounded. His masterful knowledge of landmine warfare was indeed a significant factor in preventing further loss of lives. Under his expert direction and obvious calm, the casualties were swiftly evacuated by medical avacuation helicopte s without further casualties. First Lieutement Adams! personal bravery and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
