Date action: 20 March 1969 Theater: Republic of Victnam

Reason: For heroism in ground combat against a hostile force in the Republic of Vietnam on 20 March 1969. Specialist Nesbitt distinguished himself while serving as a machine cunner in the First Platoon of Company A, 1st Battalion, 502d Infantry, near the A Shau Valley, Republic of Vietname. Thile still in contact with North Vietnamese Army Regulars entrenched in bunkers, and under continuous fire from small arms, automatic weapons, and rocket propelled grenades, Specialist Nesbitt continued to provide suppressive fire against the enemy positions. Even though seriously wounded, he continued to fire his machine gun until the enemy bunker was eliminated. Specialist Nesbitt's personal bravery and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Arty.
