Lieutenant Zapert distinguished himself while serving as a platoon leader in Company $E$, lst Battalion, 50Ist Infandy during the conduct of a search and clear mission approximately twelve kilometers southest of the village of Phat Loc, Thaia Thien Province, Reprablic of Vietnam. On the cited date, the Reconnaissance Platoon of Company $E$ observed a platoon size enemy force moving in its direction. Setting up a hasty ambush, Lieutenan, Zapert deployed his men in a strategic fighting position. In the ensuing battle, with complete disregard for his own safety, he openly moved through the intense fire to his men as he poined out targets. His actions were most instmmental in routing the enemg force and contributed immeasurably to the death of two enemy soldiers and the capture of another. Lfeutenant Zapert's personal bravery and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Ar"y.
