Reason:

For hercism in ground combat against a hostile force in the Republic of Vietnem on 6 May 1970. Private Pope distinguished himself while serving as a riflemen in Company A, 2d Dettalion (Airmobile), 501st Infantry, defending Fire Support Base Henderson, Republic of Vietnam. During an intense morter and sapper attack, a fire started at the amminition, storage point and blocked access to a friendly beleasuered recommaissance element. Subjecting himself to the exploding munitions, Private Pope maneuvered through the burning area to aid wounded comrades in the besieged sector. Despite the constant danger, Private Pope maneuvered from position to position, rendering medical aid and carrying the wounded personnel to an evacuation zone. Private Pope's personal bravery and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
