Awarded: The Bronze Star Medal with "V" Device

Date of service: 6 May 1970

Theater: Republic of Vietnam


Authority: By direction of the President of the United States under the provisions of Executive Order 11046.

Reason: For heroism in ground combat against a hostile force in the Republic of Vietnam on 6 May 1970. Sergeant Schorr distinguished himself while serving as a squad leader in Company A, 2d Battalion (Airmobile), 501st Infantry, defending Fire Support Base Henderson, Republic of Vietnam. During an intense mortar and sapper attack, a fire started at the ammunition storage point and blocked access to a beleaguered reconnaissance element. Subjecting himself to the exploding munitions, Sergeant Schorr maneuvered through the burning area to aid wounded comrades in the besieged sector. Despite the constant danger, Sergeant Schorr directed his men in establishing a defensive perimeter, then directed medical evacuation helicopters into the area. Sergeant Schorr's personal bravery and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
