AWARD OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL WITH "V" DEVICE

Awarded: The Bronze Star Medal with "V" Device

Date of Service: 20 December 1970

Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Authority: By direction of the President of the United States under the provisions of Executive Order 11046.

Reason: For heroism in ground combat against a hostile force in the Republic of Vietnam on 20 December 1970. Lieutenant Campagne distinguished himself while serving as a platoon leader of Company E, 2d Battalion (Airmobile), 501<sup>st</sup> Infantry, during combat operations in Thua Thien Province, Republic of Vietnam. While on a reconnaissance patrol, Lieutenant Campagne's platoon came under intense hostile fire and sustained two serious casualties reacting immediately, Lieutenant Campagne subjected himself to the intense hostile fire to pull the wounded to a relatively secure area. Returning to his position, he called for and directed accurate serial artillery on the enemy emplacements. His actions were instrumental in saving the life of one of his men and in lessening the threat of any further casualties. Lieutenant Campagne's personal bravery and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
