For heroism in ground combat against a hostile force in the Republic of Vietnam on 27 April 1970. Sergeant Brinker distinguished himself while serving as a member of the reconnaissance plateon of Company E, 2d Battalion (Airmetile), 502d Infantry, on a search-and-clear mission in Thua Thien Province, Republic of Vietnam. While clearing an enemy bunker complex, the unit came under heavy enemy fire. With the other members of his plateon, Sergeant Brinker moved from bunker to bunker, engaging the enemy at close range until all the enemy positions were silenced. Sergeant Brinker's personal bravery and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
