AWARD OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL WITH "V" DEVICE

TC 439. The following AWARD is announced.

IVY, ROBERT J. SP4 11B20 Co A 2d Bn (Ambi) 501st Inf (Airmobile)

Awarded: The Bronze Star Medal with "V" Device
Date of service: 31 March 1971 and 1 April 1971
Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Authority: By direction of the President of the United States under the provisions
of Executive Order 11046.

Reason: For heroism in connection with ground operations in the Republic of Vietnam, Specialist Four Ivy distinguished himself on 31 March 1971 and 1 April 1971 while serving as a squad leader during combat operations in Quang Binh Province, Republic of Vietnam. Coming under an enemy mortar and rifle attack, Specialist Ivy delivered suppressive fire while his squad set up a defensive perimeter from which to better engage the enemy. He continued to engage the enemy until the hostiles were routed from the area. On the following day, his squad again came in contact with the enemy. In organizing his squad, he delivered accurate and devastating suppressive fire which silenced the enemy positions. Specialist Four Ivy's personal bravery and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
