involving conflict with an armed hostile force in the Republic of Vistnam: Captain Carpenter distinguished himself by emcaptionally valorous entions during the period 9 June 1966 to 11 June 1966 while serving as Commending Officer of an infantry company engaged in a blocking mission near Ton Morong Outpost. As Captain Carpenter's company advanced, the lead plateon suddenly received intense fire from an estimated two companies of Vist Cong. Captain Carpenter immediately deployed the company to continue its forward progress, but it soon became planed down by extremely heavy hostile fire from three directions. After Captain Carpenter organised a heaty defense, it became apparent that the insurgent force was at least of battalion size. The insurgents lamnohed a determined frontal attack and were successful in overrunning one plateon. Realizing the severe consequences if the enemy forces were able to penetrate the entire company area, Captain Carpenter ordered supporting jet aircraft to drop napalm discetly on the company's position. The mapsim bombs hit the top of the trees in the center of the company position and detonated 25 feet above the ground. As a result, the flery mapalm carried directly into the charging insurgents and passed over most of the friendly troops. The skillfully directed air strike completely subdued the Viet Cong attempt to overron the company. As the insurgents withdraw, Captain Corpenter repeatedly exposed himself to the hostile fire to reorganize his command and direct supporting artillery fire. Throughout the remainder of the three day batthe and in the face of almost overwhalming odds, Captain Carpenter continued to direct and inspire the company to repulse three additional determined assaults by the enemy battalion. Through Captain Carpenter's heroic actions and courageons tenacity, his company was apared momerous casualties and was able to withstend the repeated attacks of the Viet Cong battalion until reinforcemente arrived. Captain Carpenter's extraordimery herdies and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest treditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his mait, and the United States Army.
