AWARD OF THE SILVER STAR
(POSTHUMOUS)

1. TC 320. The following AWARD is announced.

EVANS, ANDREW C. PRIVATE FIRST CLASS E3 United States Army
Co A 2d Bn (Abn), 502d Inf, 1st Bde, 101st Abn Div, APO 96347

Awarded: Silver Star (Posthumously)

Date action: 11 May 1966

Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: For gallantry in action: Private First Class Evans distinguished himself on 11 May 1966 during a search and destroy operation near the Cambodian border in the Republic of Vietnam. Private First Class Evans was a member of the flank security when the leading element received intense fire from extremely close range. One man was seriously wounded by the initial volume of fire and fell in an open area. Private First Class Evans with complete disregard for his safety dashed into the open area and dragged the fallen trooper to safety. Since the platoon was unable to maneuver due to the intense hostile fire, Private First Class Evans aggressively assaulted a Viet Cong position. As he rushed through the dense vegetation firing from his hip, he killed one insurgent and wounded another before being mortally wounded himself. Following the superb and inspiring example set by Private First Class Evans, his comrades aggressively assaulted and overran the insurgent positions. Private First Class Evans' extraordinary heroism in close combat against a numerically superior hostile force was in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflects great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
