AWARD OF THE SILVER STAR (POSTATIMOUS)

DEISHER, LAWRENCE J. PRIVATE FIRST CLASS E3 United States Army Co A, 2d En (Abn), 5024 Inf, 1st Bde, 101st Abn Div, APO 96347

Avardec: Silver Star (Posthumously)

Date action: 9 June 1966 Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: For gallantry in action: Private First Class Deisher distinguished nimself on 9 June 1966 while serving as a member of a equad on a combat operation near Dak To, Republic of Vietnam, When his squad was engaged by a large Viet Cong force, Private First Class Deisher while exposed to the hostile fire, killed two Viet Cong. He continued to place suppressive fire on the insurgents to enable his squad to move to good defensive positions. Secause of the numerical superiority of the Viet Cong force and intense hostile machine gun fire, the squad was pinned down. Private First Class Deisher, with complete disregard for his safety, moved forward under the supporting fire of his squad and assaulted to within fifteen meters of the hostile machine gun emplacement. He killed two Viet Cong with a sell placed hand gronade before he was mortally wounded by a burst of hostile fire. Private First Class Deisher's unimpeathable valor in close combat against a numerically superior Viet Cong force was in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflects great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
