Awarded: Silver Star Date action: 8 May 1966 Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: For gallantry in action: Sergeant Bear distinguished himself on 8 May 1966 during a search and destroy mission near Bu Gia Map, Republic of Vietnam. While enroute to join the rest of the company, Sergeant Pear's platoon received intense hostile fire from a wellfortified Viet Cong force. After observing his platcon leader in a precarious position ofruggling to free himself from some tangled vines while directly in the line of hostile fire, Sergmant Bear charged and silenced a Viet Cong position. Although he was exposed to the Viet Cong fire, Sergeant Bear succeeded in reaching his platoon leader. Later while pursuing the withdrawing Viet Cong, his plateon ran into a second Viet Cong position. Acting as point man, Sergeant Bear began to reconnoiter the area by fire and forced the hidden insurgents to fire prematurely. Although wounded, Sergeant Bear continued to fire on the Viet Cong positions which were only 50 meters away. As a result, he prevented an ambieh. Sergeant Bear's extraordinary heroism in close combat against a hostile force was in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflects great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
