1. TC 320. The following AWARD is announced,

FIRST LIEUTEMANT IMPANTRY United States Army HOLDORN. ALDEM J Company B, 2d Battalion (Airborne), 502d Infantry, APO San Francisco 96347.

Awarded: Silver Star

Date action: 9 November 1965 Thanter: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: Gallantry in action: First Lieutement Holborn's platoon was given the mission of reinforcing a squad from the reconnsissance platoon

which had become engaged with a numerically superior force. Upon reaching the enemy position, Lieutenant Holborn immediately had his platoon lay down a base of fire for the beleaguered squad. Licutenant Hollorn attempted to maneuver his platoon into position so as to make a flanking assault but encountered a heavy volume of enery fire that inflicted four casualties. Determining that his position had become precarious, be personally supervised the evacuation of the wounded and the relocation of his platoon to a better position. With complete disregard for his own personal safety, Lieutenant Holborn personally moved forward under enemy fire and carried a wounded courade to a safe position. After supporting artillery fire had been called in on the enemy positions, Lieutenent Holborn's platoon attempted another assault on the enery and successfully overran their positions. Lieutenant Hollorn repeatedly exposed himself to enemy fire while giving his men encouragement and helping the wounded and was inspirational in the final assault on the enemy position. Lieutenant Holborn's outstanding display of leadership and gallantry in action is in keeping with the highest military traditions and reflects great credit upon biaself, his unit, and the Onited States Army,
