Beason: Callantry in action: Private Pirst Class Swith, with his unit, was belilifted to aid in the attack on a heavily fortified village. After ten minutes on the ground Private Suith's unit sustained several casualties and the situation bacame critical. Private Smith, without orders, began a one hundred meter crowl directly toward the enemy, although he was receiving heavy fire and was in grave danger. Upon reaching a trench, Private Saith began threwing hand granades into the enemy positions. The Viet Cong spotted him and began throwing grenades back. Codeunted, and with complete disregard for his our life, Private Smith began picking up Virt Cong grenndes and throwing them back. Soon Private Smith was out of amminition and greendes and had to call for more. His conrades, some one hundred maters away, were tomble to help him for almost ten mimites. Private Smith then received several grenades that were thrown to him by his comrades in the rear. After egain expending all his granules, Private Suith called for more, but was unheard since all friendly forces were heavily engaged. He then rejoined his comrades and urged then to return to his previous location. Private smith accounted for at least twelve energy killed and payed the way for the assault which, together with actions of other friendly forces, routed a well armed enemy force from its prepared defenses. Private Smith's actions are in keeping with the highest traditions of the American fighting man and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United
