REACH, KARL L. FIRST LIEUTENANT INFANTRY United States Army Co C, 2d Bn (Abn), 502d Inf, 1st Bde, 101st Abn Div, APO 96347

Awarded: Silver Star Date action: 11 May 1966 Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: For gallantry in action: First Lieutenant Beach distinguished himself on 11 May 1966 while serving as executive officer flying overhead reconnaissance for his company which was comhicting a search and destroy operation mear Bu Cia Map, Republic of Vietnam. At approximately 0900 hours, the company made contact with a large Viet Cong force. Ouring the course of action, first Lieutenant Beach descended onto the battlefield by a rope which was attached to a medical evacuation belicopter. Immediately upon landing, First Lieutenant Beach began to organize and supervise the evacuation of the dead and wounded. After leading a detail forward to retrieve the casculties, First Lieutenant Beach braved hostile fire while carrying two fallen comrades to a covered position. After this, he moved wounded personnel to a more secure area and provided ammunition resupply to the platoons. Throughout the day, First Lieutenant Seach moved throughout the battle area, while exposed to hostile fire and encouraged the engaged troopers. Through his courageous actions, he saved the lives of two wounded and contributed impasurably in routing the Insurgents. First Lieutenant Beach's extraordinary herolam in close combat against a numerically superior Viet Cong force was in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflects great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
