AWARD OF THE SILVER STAR

1. TC 320. The following AWARD is announced.

CAPTAIN INFANTRY United States Army MURPHY, ROBERT C. Co C, 2d Bn (Abn), 502d Inf, 1st Bde, 101st Ahn Div, APO US Yorces

Date action: 7 February 1966 Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: For gallantry in action: Captain Marphy distinguished himself on 7 February 1966 while serving as tempony commander during t search and destroy mission mear My Canh, Republic of Vistnam. Whan the lead elements of his company received appractic eniper fire on the approach to the village, Captain Murphy isomediately deployed his troops and initiated an assault on the Viet Cong positions. As the assault line neared the heatile emphasization, the insurgent force unleashed a concentrated value of automatic weapons fire from well-fortified surkers. After ordering have troops to withdraw, Captain Mirphy exposed himself to the deadly fire, skillfully directed effective air strikes on the Viet Corp. positions, and supervised the evacuation of casualties. After nightfall, Captain Murphy personnally led a small ratrol to a position within five meters of a Vist Cong machine gum to extract the body of a faller patrol leader. Ca the following morning, Captain Murphy led a successful assault on the village. Mirong: his courage and outstanding leadership, he contributed buseaunship to the defeat of the Viet Cong force. Captain Hurphy's extraordinary heroism in close combat against a numerically superior heshile force was in keeping with the highest traditions of the military security and reflects great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
