Reason: For gallantry in action: Platoon Sergeant Rounseville distinguished himself on 11 May 1966 while serving as acting platoon leader during a search and destroy mission near Bu Giz Map, Republic of Vietnam. While moving his platoon through dense jungle and into an ascault position, Platoon Sergeant Rounseville received intense hostile fire. He immediately maneuvered his platoon up a hill against an estimated Viet Cong squad which was supported by a machine gun. Flatcon Sergeant Rounseville repeatedly exposed himself to the hestile fire by moving along the assault line and directing his men. He then led his platoon forward while firing his weapon and throwing hand grenades. Platoon Sergeant Rounseville killed at least three Viet Cong, and his platoon completely routed the insurgents from their fortified positions. Through his courage and outstanding leadership, he contributed immeasurably to the success of the mission. Plateon Sergeant Rounseville's extraordinary heroism in close combat against a hostile force was in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflects great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
