RANEY, ROMALD J. SPECIALIST FIVE E5 United States Army HHC, 2d Bn (Atm), 502d Inf, 1st Ede, 101st Abn Div, APO 35 Forces 96347

Awarded: Silver Star (First Oak Leaf Cluster)

Date action: 6 Petruary 1966 Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: For gallantry in action: Specialist Five Raney distinguished himself on 6 February 1966, while serving as a member of a company during a combat operation near the village of Cant Tinh, Republic of Vietnam. Specialist Five Rangy was moving with the company command element when a radio operator was seriously wounded in an open field. Immediately Specialist Pive Raney rushed seventy-five deters across the open field to the canualty. Although he was constantly exposed to intense eniper fire, Specialist Five Raney rendered first aid and carried the man back to safety. Within minutes, two men were seriously wounded. Despite intense hostile fire, he ran across a log bridge, picked up the injured soldiers, and helped them across one hundred meters of upen rice maddles to a medical evacuation site. While directing the approach of a medical helicopter, the insurgents placed intense fire into the intended landing cone. Specialist Five Raney then, with great professional ingenuity, waved the helicopter away, constructed two poncho raits and, while swimming beside them, floated both capualties down river to a more secure landing zone. During the ensuing assoult on the village of Carl Tinh, Specialist Five Raney, though completely exposed to enery fire, treated three wore won and carried them to salety. Later, a man was wounded two bundred meters to his front. Disregarding the hostile fire. Specialist Five Raney ran through the open area, picked up the man, and carried him to a treeline. Through Specialist Five Raney's gallant efforts and devotion to duty, the lives of six men were saved. His unimpeachable valor in close combat against a numerically superior hostile force was in keeping with the Mighest traditions of the military service and reflects great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Aray.
