Reason: For gallantif in action against a hostile force on 13 and 14 August 1967 noor Duc Pho, Republic of Victues. As Pirst Lieutement Courtney to company prepared to move from a landing some after an airmobile assault, it was attacked by a North Vistamese Army Battalion aroud with groundes, cortars, heavy machinagues and automatic weapons. Limitonant Courtney was instructed to mensurer his plateen to snother portion of the hastily constructed parimeter to assist a platoon which had berne the brunt of the initial attack. Aftar Ideutenam Courtney had reached the other platean and positioned his man, a well dug-in machinogum opened fire pinning down both plotoons, Without concern for his own safety, Lightenant Courtney stood up, exposing himself to the withering encay fire, and calaly threw two granades suto the machineous position which tadly damaged the gun and willed two enemy soldiers. The energy slewent then commenced a flanking concuver. Observing this, Lieutenant Courtney, again with no regard for his own safes ty, picked up a mechinagun and moved through the devestating fire completely amposed. He engaged the flunking eremy from a pesition well forward of the perinter and his offective fire forced the heatile furge to withdraw, leaving several dead and wet ided. His aggressive spirit and courageous deeds rallied the men in both platoone and were instrumental in the ultimate victory over a numerically superior North Viatameao Amy force, First Lisutonant Courtney's inquestionable valor was in keeping with the finest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, the Americal Division, and the United Statem LIOT.
