AWARD OF THE SILVER STAR (NEST O.K LET.F EDISTRIK)

Pate action: 13 and 14 August 1957

Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: For gallentry in action against on armod hostile energ on 13 and 14 August 1967 near thu Ini, Republic of Wetner. At approximately 1700 hours on 13 August 1967, Company B, 2nd Battelien (Airborno), 502d Infantry, conducted a helicopter assault into an area worth west of Che Lai. Shortly after the last elements of the company had landed, a plateon moving down the hill from the landing zene was suddenly taken under heavy energy automatic weapons fire, Captein Cica impositely directed the platoon to pull back to the landing zone where he quickly organized a company perimeter defense. Shortly after, an estimated insurgent Battalion initiated a full scale attack on the friendly positions. As the enemy element began to place a trememous volume of automotic weapons, mortar, rocket, and rifle granade fire into the friendly positions, Captain Odon exposed histolf to the heavy enery fire while sowing among his center positions giving them opcouragement and directing their five by pointing out energy positions. For over thirteen hours the battle raged and Captain Cion directed extremely effective supporting fire from artillery, gunships and flare ships. The Astermined enery element continued to assault the friendly positions with human wave assoult teams time and time again. MEerrus times Captain Odom with complete disregard for his own personal safety, dashed through the bullet swept area and aulied wounded men to safety and gave them medical sid. During the entire battle Captain Odom displayed such a high degree of heroion that his men became so inspired by his action that they ware sule to successfully defend their positions from the determined energy force. When the bottle ended and the entry clasent withdraw, thirty five charg dead were counted, eighteen outcoatic and semi-automatic weapons were captured and also two machineguas and two rocket launchers. Captain Olca's outstending display of collector in the face of insurmountable odds, is in beeping the highest military traditions and reflects immeasurable credit upon himself, Task Force Oregon and the United States army.
