Reason: Gallantry in action: Private First Class Hawkins distinguished himself by gallantry in action while engaged in military operations against an armed hostile force in the Rapublic of Victors on 10 Hovember 1967, while serving with Company B, 2d Zattalien (Airborne), 502d Infantry, 1st Brigade, 101st Airborne Division. While on a reconnaissance patrol near Chu Lai, Private Hawkins! squad came under an intense volume of automatic weapons fire from well entrenched enemy positions. With the initial bursts of fire, Private Hawkins, with complete disregard for his personal sefety, rushed forward to the point element of his squad and began firing into the enemy positions. Realizing that rifle fire alone could not kill or rout the enery from their positions, he courageously charged forward, burling granades. After granading several enemy positions, he was mortally wounded by enemy fire. Wis heroic actions inspired his commades to assault the enemy positions and rout them from the battle area, resulting in three enemy soldiers killed and the capture of two enemy automatic weapons. Private Hawkins! extraordinary heroism in close combat was in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflects great credit upon himself, his wait and the United States Army.
