Date action: 13 August 1967 Theater: Republic of Viotram

Reason: For gallantry in action against a hostile force on 13 August 1967 near Duo Pho, Republic of Tietnen. After conducting au airmobile assault into a mined landing zone, 2d platoon of Company B, 2d Battalion (Airborne), 502d Infantry, moved through the open to a tree line. Approximately thirty meters from the trees, they came under intense autoretic weapons fire from a North Vietnemese Army platoon. The point man was wounded from the initial burst of fire. Observing his plateen sergeant having trouble moving the man, Private First Class Komp, with complete disregard for his own personal safety, justed from his concealed position and ran through the intense energy fire to aid his fallon commide. He then carried the man through the Withering fire and through a minefield to a Medevae helicopter. Upon his return to the battle area, Private Kemp was wounded by an enemy grenade. Blaregarding his wound end the heavy enemy fire, Private Kemp again aided a wounded man and carried him through the energy fire and mincfield to be evacuated, Private Kemp's coolness and undarented courage on the battlefield was instrumental in inspiring his plateon to route a superior energ force which left behind 3 dead and mumcrous weapons. Private First Class Keom's outstanding display of gallantry in action and aggressive devotion to duty are in Resping with the highest traditions of the military mrvice and reflect great credit upon himself, the Americal Division, and
