AWARD OF THE SILVER STAR

1. TC 320. The following AWARD is announced.

CUTIEDEZ, LIONEL FRIVATE FIRST CLASS E3, United States Army, Company B, 2d Battalion (Airborne), 502d Infantry, 1st Brigade, 101st Airborne Division ATO 96347

Awarded: Silver Star Date action: 18 May 1967 Theater: Remublic of Vietnam

Reason: For gallantry in action against a hostile force on 18 May 1967 near Duc Fho, Republic of Vietnam. While on a search and destro; mission, Frivate First Class Gutierrez's rictoon was suddenly taken under a tremendous volume of enemy automatic wearons fire. In the initial stages of the fire fight numerous casuslties were inflicted. Then another pletoon roved into the area to assist, they too were brought under intense fire and minned down. Private Gutierrez moved through the vicious energy fire with complete disregard for his own safety to an exposed resitio. where he could best give the pinned-down platoon covering fire. Seeing that a wounded man lay in an area exposed to hostile fire Trivate Gutierres rushed forward to aid the wounded soldier. Flacing himself between the wounded man and the enerw positions, Private Gutierres began to administer much-needed first aid, While giving the wounded man aid, Frivate Outierrez began recaiving heavy automatic fire. Unable to locate the enemy soldier's exact position, Frivate Cutierrez deliberately exposed himself to draw the enemy fire so that he might rinpoint the position. Frivate Gutierrez continued to expose himself until he located the energy positions and then succeeded in killing the enemy soldier. Trivate First Class Gutierrez's unmuestionable valorous actions were in keering with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, the Americal Division, and the United States Army.
