As he approached the battle area, his plateon suddenly received intense Vist Cong small arms and automatic weapons fire causing several casualties. Realising that further efforts to advance would result in numerous losses. Sergeant Conseles called for reinforcements and an air strike. After directing the air strike, he organised his platoon for an assent. Because of the well fortified Viet Cong positions, he was forced to stop short of the objective. Observing that two squad leaders had been wounded, Sergeant Consulus reorganised his platoon and started forward again. After moving approximately 20 meters, they received intense hostile fire and enstained additional campalties. He then set up an extraction point and supervised the evacuation of the wounded. After the wonded were evaported, Sergeant Consiler assembled his battle weary platoon, and one egain assaulted the enemy fortifications. Sarguant Consales, at the head of ids platoon, charged forward and ran 50 meters across the open rice paddy, oblivious of the mithering fire that enguised the battlefield and that tore may his equipment and knocked off his belief. His nen, spirited by this almost unbelievable sot of herden, assaulted behind their plateon sergeant and routed the energy from its prepared defenses. Surgeant Conselast extraordinary bergin in close combat against a manerically superior bostile force is in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflects great credit upon himself, his unit and the United States Arev.
